


About us




Why applying?

Organizing the first ECOP forum was an enormous challenge for young ambassadors, but the experience and the outcomes proved that it was worth it














ECOP Network Forum

Main outcomes: challenges of being an ECOP **ECOP** Network



- Funding: to participate & get trained, job insecurity
- **Time:** short-term positions make it difficult to engage
- **Training**: in (complex) policy & communication

Main outcomes: challenges of being an ECOP



- Connection: with policy people
- Organization of science & policy institutions: hierarchy & complexity
- Including ECOPs as
- keynotes, panellists-not only ECOP-related
- actors in decision-making for labs, projects, working groups
